Crafty Corner



Materials:

Leaves, paper, toilet paper roll, brown marker, liquid glue, brush, scissor.

Instructions:

1. Take your little one on a nature walk and pick some fallen leaves.
2. Spread them out and let them dry for a bit, not too dry as they will start crumbling.
3. Prepare your glue and brush and cut the paper roll in half.
4. Ask your child to colour with brown markers the two pieces of the roll.
5. Using the brush let your child glue the trunk pieces on a piece of paper to form the trunk of the tree and decorate the tree with the leaves to form the branches.
